

Production Intern

PURPOSE

To assist with the production of high quality seed corn by executing a variety of tasks based on field operations, bulk seek processing, warehousing, and distribution needs.

DIMENSION/FUNCTION

The Production Intern ensures all required processes and procedures are successfully completed within the seed corn operation. This position is located in Atkinson, IL.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This list of duties and responsibilities is not all inclusive and may be expanded to include other responsibilities as management may deem necessary from time to time.

- Schedule and dispatch vehicles for return of seed during backhaul.
- Set up and maintain packaging supplies such as product tags, bagger and FastFill containers.
- Re-bag backhaul (returned) seed including labeling, tagging, bagging and palletizing seed corn.
- Organize, store, and maintain inventory of bulk and bagged seed utilizing electronic inventory system and entering information into a computer.
- Obtain seed samples for quality assurance.
- Interact and maintain a positive working relationship with growers, detasseling and roguing contractors, Field Inspectors, and Detasseling Machine Operators.
- Conduct field inspections for quality checks.
