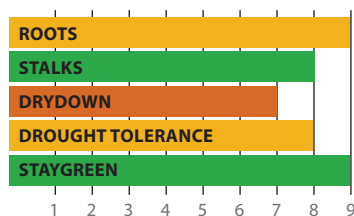

### CONTINUOUS CORN MANAGEMENT

- If corn rootworm management is needed, consider using a proven soil insecticide or choose a hybrid with a corn rootworm trait.
- Good choice for fields with a history of Goss' wilt.

LEGEND: E = early for maturity, A = average for maturity, L = late for maturity; M = medium, MS = medium short, MT = medium tall, T = tall; H = high, MH = medium high, ML = medium low; F = flex, SF = semi-flex, D = determinate, SD = semi-determinate. Numerical ratings are based on comparisons among Wyffels hybrids of like maturity where 1 = Low, 5 = Avg, and 9 = High expressions of a trait.

### PLACEMENT / MANAGEMENT

Excellent late season appearance and strong roots and stalks allow for later harvest. Well adapted to various soil types. Above average tar spot tolerance. Semi-flex ear works over a range of populations.
